- 🌟 O Canada! Did you know that the Heritage Horns sound the first four notes of our national anthem everyday at noon? The horns are located on top of Canada Place. The horns blow at 115 decibels and can be heard throughout downtown and on the North Shore.
- 🌟 The Canada Place Sails of Light are illuminated each evening from dusk to dawn, with seasonal vibrant colours, displays and animation. The five sails are also illuminated to recognize and raise awareness of various causes.
- 🌟 The Port of Vancouver Cruise Terminal at Canada Place welcomes over 890,000 passengers each year as the homeport for many of the Alaska cruises.
